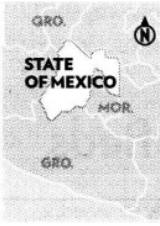

Peña tours flood-affected zones



EL POTRERO - The governor of the State of Mexico, Enrique Peña Nieto, toured the El Potrero community to oversee relief work provided to the victims of

massive flooding that took place last week.

Damaged drainage systems produced flooding that left a mess of entangled cars, personal belongings and severely damaged houses and buildings in several communities throughout the Tlalnepantla and Atizapán municipalities.

Peña Nieto stated that about 400 houses were affected by the overflow of Atizapán Canal. After listen-

ing to demands and complaints from the communities, Peña Nieto declared that, "No family will be left without support."

The government is awaiting assessments from the National Water Commission (**Conagua**) to determine exactly what went wrong before proceeding with repairs to the canal and wastewater infrastructure.
